The program is funded through abandoned Capital Credits, funds that would otherwise be forfeited to the State of Florida allowing us to transform lost dollars into life-changing opportunities.

Looking ahead to 2026, we are thrilled to announce an expansion of this initiative from 110 high school seniors to 130 that will be selected to receive \$12,000 each toward tuition for college or technical education, representing \$1,560,000 in scholarships.




Fuel Rate Reduction

Effective November 1, 2025, Members will see a decrease of \$2.00 per 1,000 kWh of usage on the fuel adjustment charge. This change reflects a decrease in the current cost of fuel purchased to generate power. Fuel is a pass-through cost, and we are pleased to pass on the savings to you the Member.
