RE: Request for Access to Restoration Areas During Emergency Recovery Operations

It is requested that electric utility restoration personnel, including subcontractors, be granted access to areas where power restoration is needed. Electric restoration personnel should provide local authorities; 1) a valid government-issued ID (driver's license or passport) and 2) proof of employment (ex: employer credentials or a letter on employer letterhead).

This letter is intended to demonstrate a need to enter areas requiring power restoration, it is not intended to supersede local emergency management and/or law enforcement authorities. This request is limited to restoration efforts presented by Hurricane Milton and is limited to 30 days in duration (with potential extensions).
