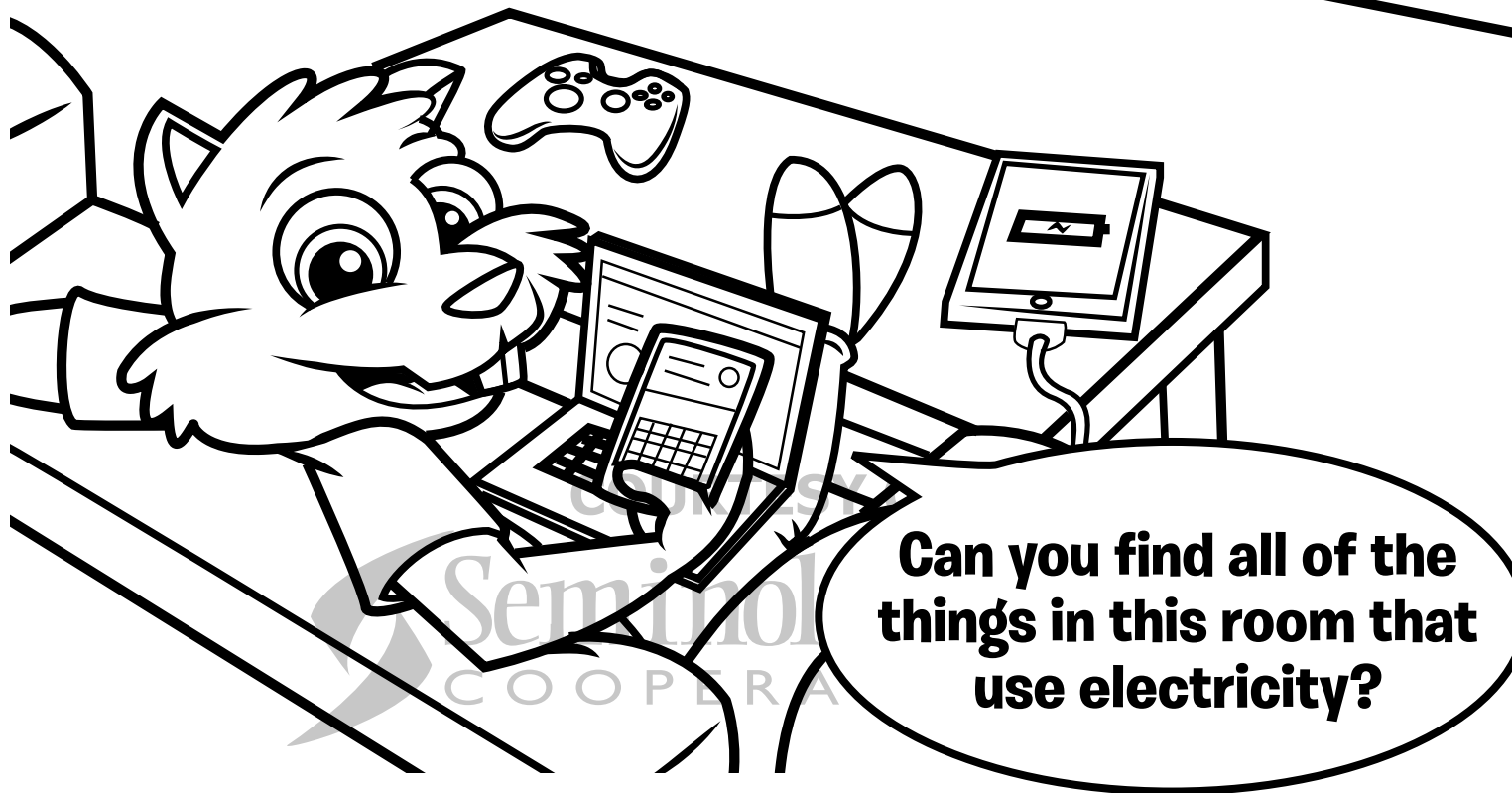
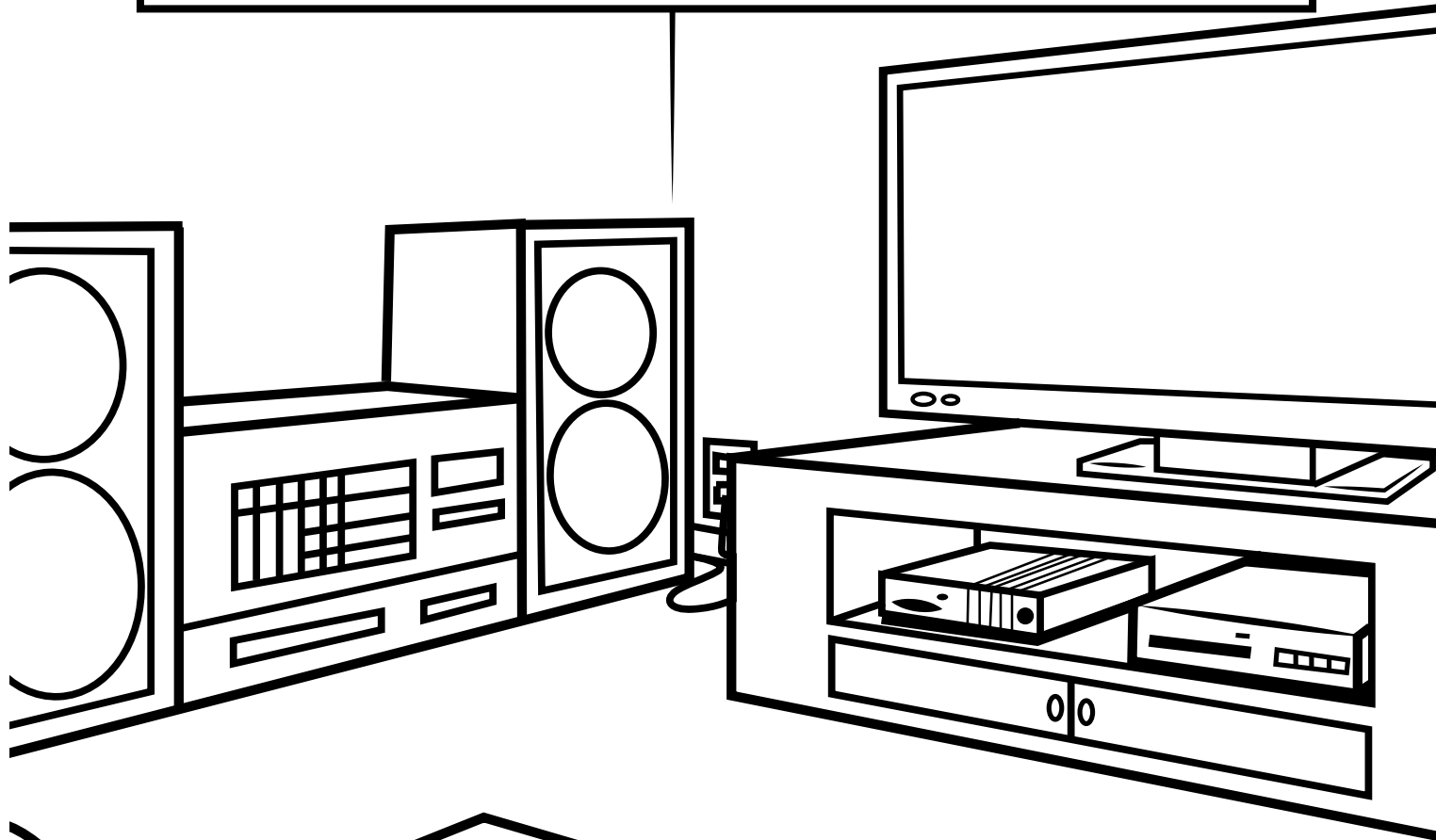
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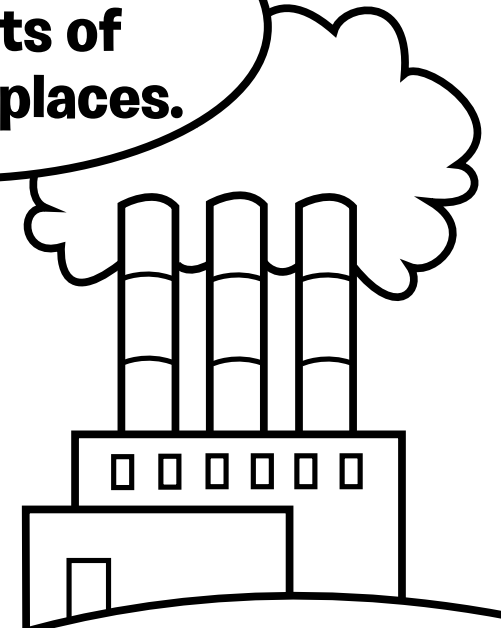
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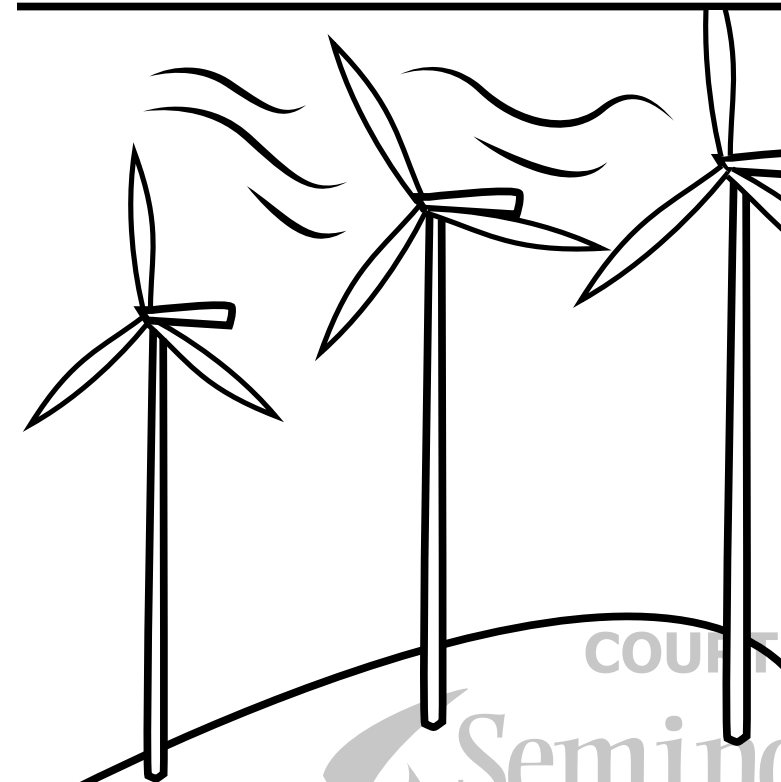
**Our homes use a lot of energy.

home uses electricity every day!**



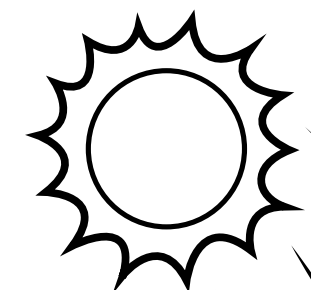
**Electricity comes

different places.**



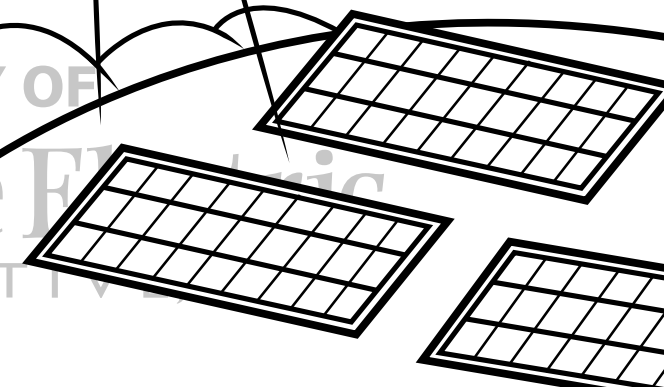
**It comes from

It can also come from wind

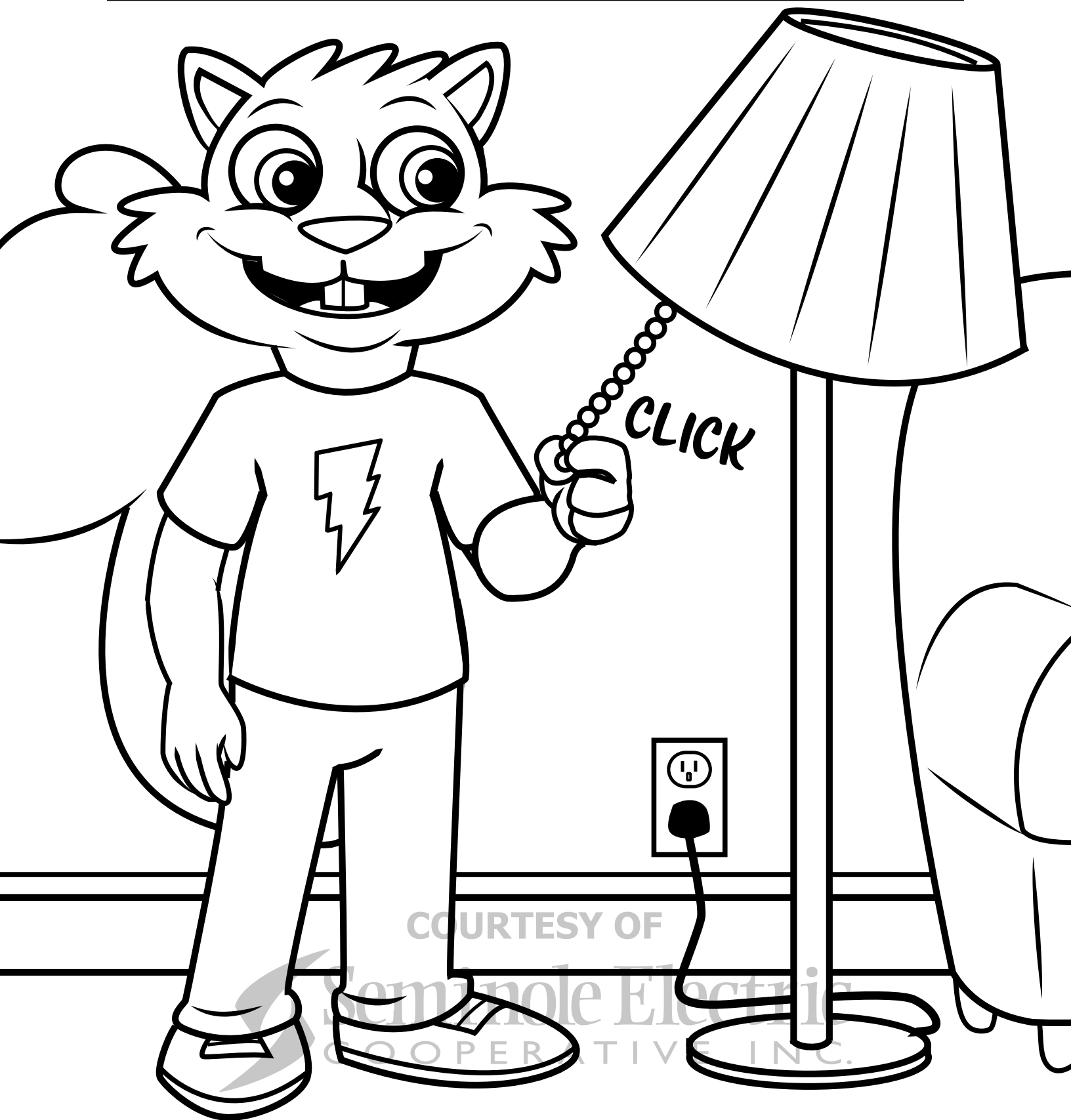


or from the sun.



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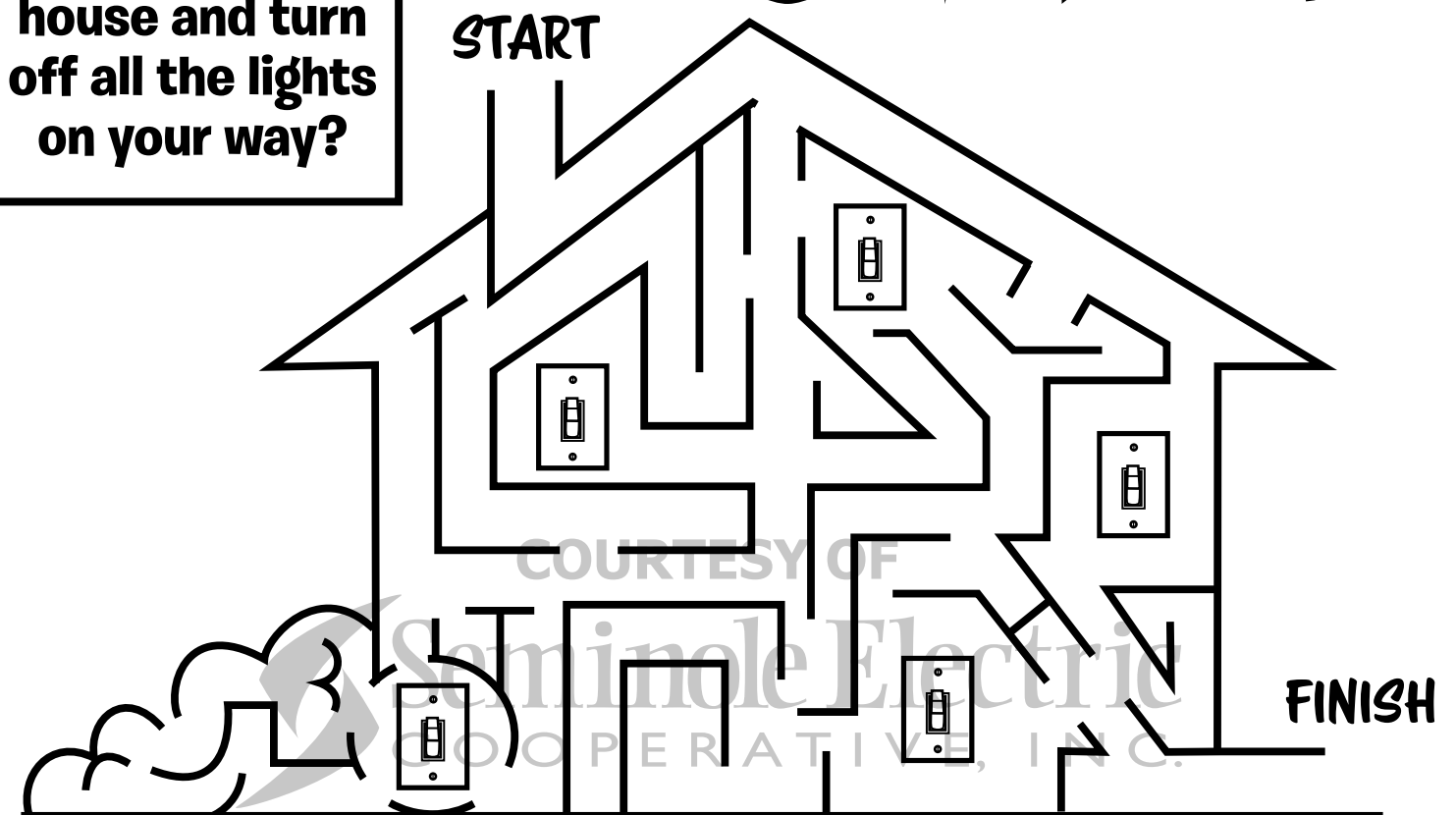
Since everyone uses energy, everyone can help save energy too! A good place to start is by turning off the lights when you leave the room.

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**Sunlight can help you save energy!
In the winter, open the drapes to let the sun help warm up your home.**



In the summer, keep the drapes closed during the day to stay cool.

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**The same goes for video games—make sure to
turn them off when you're not using them.**



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Phones, tablets, and laptops can keep using electricity when they are plugged in, even if they are done charging, so unplug them when they are powered up.



If you're cold, put on a sweater instead of turning the thermostat up.



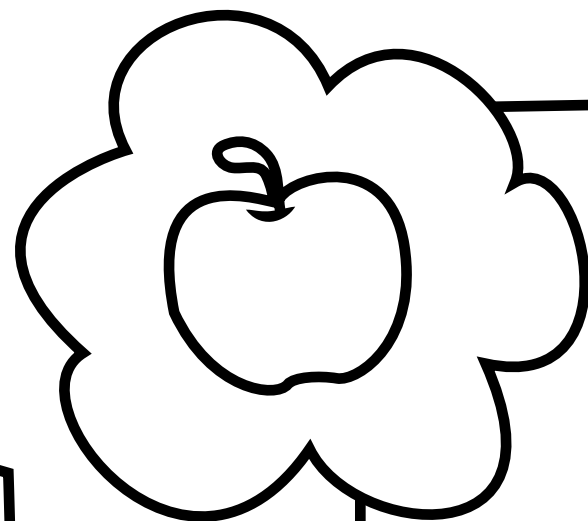
If you're hot, use a fan instead of the air conditioner.



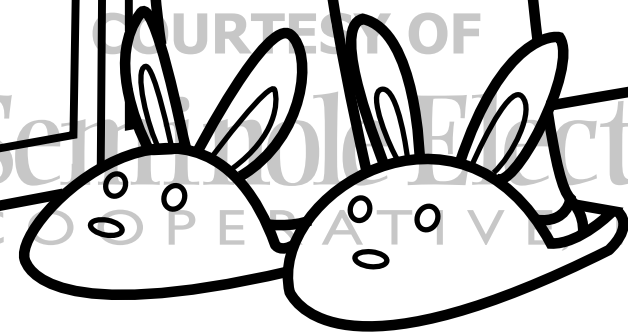
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Your fridge uses a lot of energy. Think about what you want before you open the door. That keeps the cool in!
