HOME SAFETY TIPS

Before starting any project be alert of where the power lines are located and know how high they are hanging. Whether you're working on the roof, trimming trees, or painting your siding, it's important to be aware and to alert others about nearby power lines.

- 1. Locate all overhead power lines.**
- 2. Stay at least 20 feet away from all overhead lines.**
- 3. Do not touch anything in contact with power lines.**
- 4. Carry ladders and equipment horizontally.**
- 5. If you are digging be sure to call 811 at least two full business days before you plan to start your project.**
- 6. Stay at least 50 feet away from downed power lines and call 911 and your local WREC office.**
